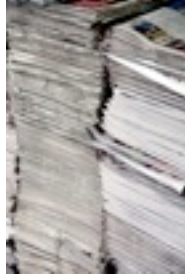

## PAPER

### ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Newspaper (Including glossy inserts)
- Typing, Writing and Computer Paper
- Discarded mail fliers
- Magazines and catalogues
- Brown paper bags
- Corrugated Boxes
- Paperboard boxes (shoe and cereal boxes)



### PREPARATION

- Place paper items in BROWN PAPER BAGS
- Remove any staples, strapping or paper clips
- Flatten Boxes
- Please remove plastic liners from Paperboard boxes
- Please do not place in plastic bags or cardboard boxes

### NOT ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Wrapping or tissue paper
- Napkins, tissues, paper towels, or wax paper
- Used paper plates or any paper with food or food stains
- Telephone books
- Paperboard boxes with plastic windows
- Wax coated or freezer boxes



## GLASS

### ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Clear glass bottles and jars

### PREPARATION

- Remove lids and discard
- Rinse clean
- Remove any metal rings, plastic or foam labels (Paper labels do NOT have to be removed)

### NOT ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Dishes or ceramics
- Light bulbs or broken windows
- Mirrors

## METAL

### ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Steel and tin cans
- Aerosol cans
- Aluminum foil and cans
- Household batteries (alkaline, rechargeable, watch, hearing aid, camera etc.)



### PREPARATION

- Rinse clean
- Remove labels
- Make sure aerosol cans are completely empty, remove caps
- Place batteries in a re-sealable plastic bag

### NOT ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Bakeware and utensils
- Pots and pans. Clothes Hangers
- Car parts or scrap metal
- Paint cans and Propane Cylinders
- Foil backed paper and gum wrappers
- Siding, window frames and doors



## PLASTIC

### ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Plastic containers with the #1-7 symbols
- Plastic grocery bags with the #2 and #4 symbols

This includes milk jugs, water bottles, detergent and shampoo bottles, butter tubs, plastic yogurt cups. Microwave food trays, plant flats, flower pots etc.

### PREPARATION

- Remove and discard caps
- Wash all food residue, heavy soil, grease, or soapy liquids from containers
- Bags must be clean and dry and have all paper and receipts removed

### NOT ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Bottles that contain automotive fluids or hazardous materials
- Styrofoam cups, plants, peanuts, packaging etc.
- Plastic bags such as garbage, food storage, dry cleaning
- Plastic film
